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Clerk advises: Council held eleven meetings, 2017/18 and minute 104/18 iv states:

"It was further resolved to hold a Precept Setting meeting in the first week of December, 2018,

to set the budget and precept for 2019/20." LGA, 1972 recognizes the title of "Chairman."

Following amendments to the Standing Orders received from Cllr Tony Graham:

- 1) That all references to 'Chairman' be amended to read 'Chair' or 'Chairperson' such choice to be agreed by the Council; and that all references to 'Vice-Chairman' be amended to read 'Vice-Chair' or 'Vice Chairperson' such choice to be agreed by the Council.
- 2) That Standing Order 2 be amended as follows:

The words "eleven ordinary meetings" be replaced with the words "nine ordinary meetings (no meetings to be held in August or December)". In addition the words "excluding the month of August and December" shall be deleted.

The word "Friday" be replaced with the word "Thursday".

The following paragraph be added at the end of the Standing Order: "Should any member fail to attend Council meetings for six consecutive months that member shall be cease to be a member of the Council".

3) That Standing Order 87 be amended as follows:

The words/numerals "86 and 87" be replaced with "85 and 86"

4) That Standing Order 86 be amended as follows:

The words "In such a case that Councillor may speak but shall not vote on the matter" be replaced with the words "In such a case that Councillor may speak and answer questions that the Council may wish to ask. That Councillor will then leave the room and shall not vote on the matter".

5) That Standing Order 86 be amended as follows:

The numerals "85" be replaced with the numerals "82-85"
